Dr. Allen C. Bowling is Medical Director of the MS Service and Director of the Complementary and Alternative Medicine at the Colorado Neurological Institute (CNI). He is also Clinical Associate Professor of Neurology at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center. From 2003-2007, he was the Medical Director of the Rocky Mountain MS Center. Publications include numerous articles in clinical and basic science journals. Additionally, he is the author or co-author of four books on MS, including *Complementary and Alternative Medicine and Multiple Sclerosis: The Guide to Treatment and Management*.
